SIMON SHAYO ELECTED TO REPRESENT THE CHAMBER IN THE TPSF BOARD FOR 2018/2019 - 2019/2020

The Tanzania Private Sector Foundation, the highest body only next to the Tanzania National Business Council, and representing private sector companies and associations, held elections for its board of directors on 27th August, 2018. The elected board members were endorsed by the Annual General Meeting of the foundation that took place yesterday at the Serena Hotel, Dar es Salaam.

This time around the Chamber was represented in the elections of the 14 member board by Mr. Simon Shayo, Vice President – Sustainability for Geita Gold Mine (Anglogold Ashanti). Simon Shayo seats in the Executive Council of the Chamber. Following his appointment he will serve in the TPSF board for a period of two years. Simon takes over from Mr. Deodatus Mwanyika, former Vice President Corporate Affairs for

Acacia Mining, who represented the Chamber during the 2016/2017 – 2017/2018 period. There were two contestants in the Extractive Industries & Energy cluster and 3 votes. Simon got 2 votes to become the victor.

The new TPSF Chairperson will now be Mr. Salum Shamte, an entrepreneur mostly known by his

interests in the Sisal sector. He is also the former Vice Chairperson of TPSF. He has replaced Dr. Reginald Mengi, the media mogul. There was a presentation by Professor Lucian Msambichaka, a seasoned Economist, on "Responsible Business Leadership for Enhanced Public Private Cooperation for Sustainable Economic Development". A well debated panel followed after the presentation. In his speech the Prime Minister re-assured the business community about the Government's commitment to reforms which will improve the business environment.
